**WE WILL GLADLY ACCEPT:**

- ❖ Children's **Spring/Summer** Clothing (Sizes newborn through 16)
- ❖ Baby & Children's Bedding, Furniture, Equipment, Accessories, etc. (non-drop-side cribs, linens, high chairs, strollers, swings...)  
**We cannot accept drop-side cribs due to a recent mandate from the Consumer Product Safety Commission banning the sale or resale of such cribs.**
- ❖ Shoes and Socks (must be in excellent condition; **shoes limited to 5 pair of girls shoes and 5 pair of boys shoes per consignor**)
- ❖ Nursing Items
- ❖ School Uniforms
- ❖ Toys, Books, Videos, Games, Puzzles, CD's, DVD's, Computer Games, Leap Frog, etc. (secure ALL loose pieces in a plastic bag)
- ❖ Sports Equipment, Bikes, Skates, Wagons, Scooters, Battery Operated Cars, etc.
- ❖ Play Equipment, Play Kitchens, Workshops, Tables & Chairs, etc.
- ❖ Dancewear, Karate Wear, Halloween Costumes & Dress Up Clothes
- ❖ Stuffed Animals that are in excellent condition (**limit of 5 per consignor**); Grab Bags that are theme oriented.

**WE ARE UNABLE TO ACCEPT:**

- ❖ Maternity clothes
- ❖ Battery operated toys **WITHOUT** the batteries
- ❖ Stained, torn, extremely worn, broken, or faded items
- ❖ Out of date items (Nothing purchased more than 5 years ago)
- ❖ Items that are broken or have missing parts
- ❖ Improperly tagged items

If you are willing to work an 8 hour shift from 1:30 – 9:30 on Thursday, March 8<sup>th</sup> during the Presale, you will be able to shop Wednesday, March 7<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 – 9:30.

If you contribute a minimum of 15 TOP quality items, you will receive 1 Presale Consigno Pass to shop on Thursday, March 8<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 to 9:00. Only those with a pass will be allowed at the presale. Due to a limited amount of space, **we request that you do no bring children with you to the presale** Each consignor will also be given 2 Gues Presale Passes to give to 2 friends to shop Thursday, March 8<sup>th</sup> from 6:45 to 9:00.

**Hanging** – Clothing must be hung on wire or heavy duty plastic hangers. We recommend wire hangers as plastic ones break and items end up on the floor. The hanger hook should face the left (like a question mark) with the tag pinned to the right side of the garment as you face it. See illustration above.

**Cards** – Only 3x5 index cards **vertically**. Use **BLUE** or **BLACK** ink if you **DO NOT** wish for the item to be sold at 1/2 price on Saturday. **Write the entire card in RED ink if you DO wish for the item to be sold at 1/2 price during the 1/2 price sale on Saturday.** Please pin the TAG to the item with a **1 inch safety pin**. No straight pins!

**Consignor #** - 1/3 way down card on the left. Make sure you have your correct # on each card. Please note that you do not have to write “Consignor #.” Instead, if you are Consignor #999, you may write “#999” rather than “Consignor #999.”

**Size** – 1/3 way down card on the right. Must be a number, **NOT** S, M, or L.

**Description** – Center of card. Give a short description of item on tag in case tag and item become separated. Example: “Girls Talbot Kids Green Jumper” instead of “green shirt.”

**HC** – (**OPTIONAL**) - means **Help Children**. Put HC at the bottom left corner of card **ONLY** if you wish unsold item to be donated to charity following the sale.

**Price** – Bottom right corner of card and top right corner of card. You set the price on all items, so price to sell. **Use \$1.00 increments** (not .50 or .99).

**Sets** – Pin the waist of the pants, shorts, or skirt to the back of the shirt with pin going through the top of the hanger.

**Shoes** – must be in perfect condition. They must be clean, have shoelaces, etc. The card must be attached to the shoes **NOT** inside a shoebox or plastic bag. Tie shoes together with a ribbon. **You are limited to 5 pairs of girls shoes and 5 pairs of boys shoes.**

**Toys, Furniture, and Equipment** – Must be clean, have all the parts, and be in working order. If batteries are required, please include them with item. Small parts should be in a clear bag and attached to the main part with a safety pin or ribbon.

**We can no longer accept drop-side cribs.**

**Loose Articles** – Such as puzzles, bows, bibs, bottles, cloth diapers, small toys, socks, etc. must be in a clear plastic bag with **the card pinned to the outside of the bag**. Please seal top of bag with clear tape.

**Hard to Tag Items** – Punch a hole or cut a slit in the index card and tie with ribbon. Tape ribbon to the item. No tape on cards please. We recommend you use heavy duty tape as scotch tape will not hold and your items may become lost if not securely attached.

### **How to Price**

Due to the many items being sold, we recommend that you price competitively. We suggest **no more than 1/3 of the original price** depending on the name brand and condition of the item. To maintain the high standards we have set, only bring items of the quality & condition that you would be willing to purchase yourself. Spending a little extra time preparing your items will mean

### **Pick Up**

You will be picking up your unsold items and your proceeds check on **Sunday, March 11<sup>th</sup>, between 11:30 and 2:00.** Remember: **Daylight savings begins March 11<sup>th</sup>, so make sure you spring forward.** If you cannot pick up your unsold items, please make arrangements with someone to pick them up for you. **ALL items left after 2:00 on Sunday will be donated immediately to charity.** **We will be deducting a \$10.00 participation fee from your total**
